Vaccinations for university staff as per Coronavirus Vaccination Ordinance
(CoronaImpfV)
University of Bonn staff resident in Rhineland-Palatinate

Dear Sir or Madam,

Following the first amendment to the Coronavirus Vaccination Ordinance dating April 30, university staff are now among the occupational groups for which the German government has agreed prioritized vaccination entitlement (priority group 3 out of 3).

However, individual states are in charge of prioritizing within this group:

Currently the first amendment to the Coronavirus Vaccination Ordinance does not have immediate impact on **university staff** living in **North Rhine-Westphalia**. Thus, as of May 06, 2021, registering at vaccination centers is **not** allowed for yet. We will notify you via distribution of a circular and the coronavirus-related sections of the University website as soon as the state of North Rhine-Westphalia confirms registrations are possible. To prepare for all eventualities, and **without requests to do so being necessary**, the University will send an informal employer's confirmation to your home address in the coming days. However, whether vaccination centers and general practitioners accept this confirmation is still to be confirmed. Please note that as a holder of the confirmation you are therefore not automatically entitled to get vaccinated immediately!

In the state of **Rhineland-Palatinate**, however, priority group 3 has been able to register for vaccinations since April 23, 2021. According to § 4 para. 1 nr. 4b CoronaImpfV, University of Bonn staff also belong to this group, including all technical and administrative staff and other staff members.

Any staff living in Rhineland-Palatinate who wish to make use of this offer must, according to § 6 para. 4 nr. 2 CoronaImpfV, present a relevant form. Please complete the attached document, available also at the following link

and send it to the responsible contact at Human Resources for signing and stamping.

You will need to bring the document along to your vaccination appointment.

To overcome this pandemic, it is essential that each member of society shows solidarity and fully cooperates. As time slots for vaccinations are not allocated through the University, staff may attend vaccination appointments during working hours. The period of absence, however, does not count as time spent working. Please inform your line manager of your absence accordingly.
